## Thank you Tim Jones

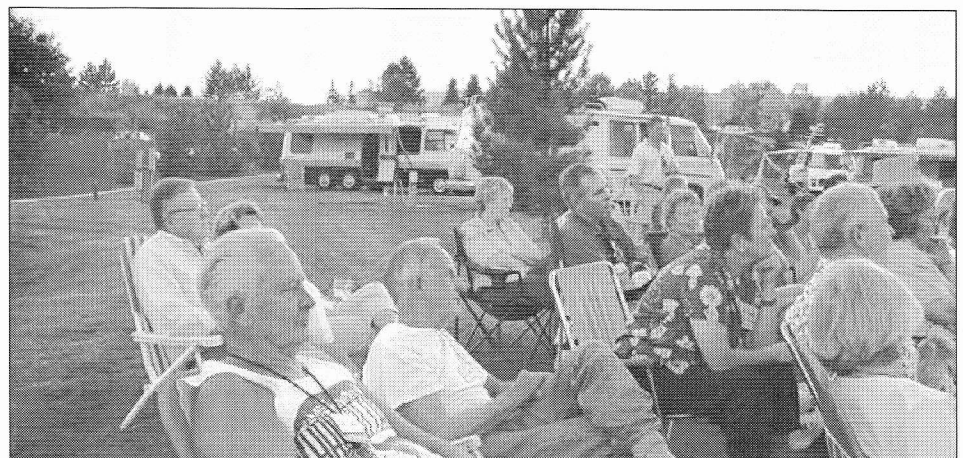
